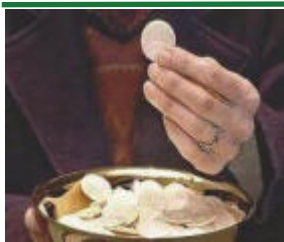
PARKING REQUEST

Distributing Communion During Mass

Here in the United States, Catholics have the right to receive Holy Communion kneeling, if they so choose, and the option of receiving while standing.

Fr. Tony reminds our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion that they are to stand Directly behind the installed kneelers, so that our parishioners can conveniently kneel or stand — as they wish.

Standing “off to one side,” or in front of the kneeler, makes it difficult, awkward, or impossible for a person who wishes to receive kneeling to do so.

THE WORD SPEAKS TO US...

For five weeks now our Gospel reading has been from the beautiful sixth chapter of St. John. The 6th chapter began with Jesus feeding a great crowd with just five loaves of bread and two fish. It developed further with Jesus telling the crowd that He had a better food to offer them; the Bread of Life, which is His very Self.

Last week we heard Jesus say, whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and I will raise him up on the last day. May God continue to strengthen our faith in Christ as the Church begins to engage in a purging of the sinful shepherds and for healing for all those harmed by the criminal and sinful actions of our leaders.

Remember, to whether this storm, we need to develop a personal relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ. As Christ calmed the storm in the time of the apostles, He will do the same for us in our present difficulties.
