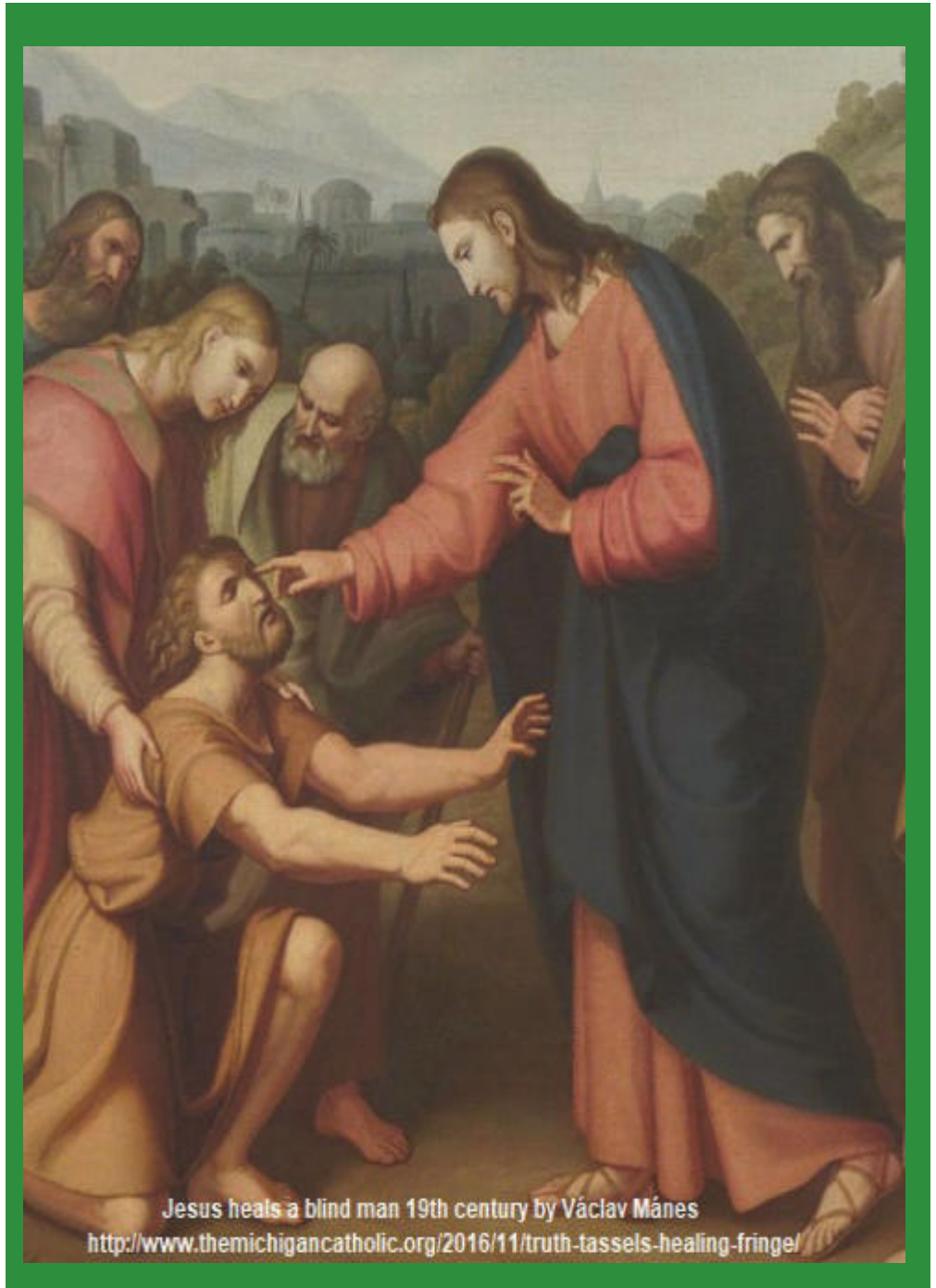

Dear Parish Family & Friends,

Well, here we are at the start of September, schools are back in session, and we look forward to the season of Autumn.

As nature begins to change, we remember that the Word of God remains always unchanged and becomes the place to which we all can go for direction and strength.

Inspiration from God's Word:

James 2:1-5 speaks to us about what dangerous favoritism can do in any family or relationship.

Our lesson from the letter of James peels back the curtain on a problem in the congregation to which he addressed his letter.

Some scholars have suggested the letter's first readers were members of the Christian community in Jerusalem where James, the "brother of the Lord," was bishop. Others suggest another venue, later in the first century. In this church — the community of Christian brothers and sisters — a dangerous favoritism had apparently reared its ugly head.

The centuries have dulled our being able to have a better understanding of this troubling situation, but the lesson seems clear: discrimination of any kind is contrary to the teachings of Jesus Christ.

The Church is to be the primary place where we receive each other truly as sisters and brothers, bonded together by the love and presence of the risen Lord. But, we know that is not always the case. Favoritism is not only a virus that can infect the church. Left unchecked, it can become toxic, diffusive, even lethal in our larger society.

At times, our beloved country still feels the sting of discrimination, division, and the vile effects of racism.

As followers of Jesus Christ, we must be ever vigilant, even prophetic, anytime someone, some ideology, or some group suggests a pecking order in the human family. Perhaps that is easier said than done! What is God saying to us to raise awareness of, and sensitivity to, the danger of playing favorites?

Perhaps we need to revisit what we learned from our parents and grandparents; TREAT EVERYONE WITH RESPECT.

So how do we guard against favoritism, a poison that can divide and wound our fellowship? We must live the Gospel truth that God loves all men and women equally. The only favoritism among God's people is the favor God shows us in Jesus Christ; we call it grace.

The Gospel declares that all of us are God's favorites. God loved us so much, favored us so highly, He sent His only Son to be our savior.

God says, "You are my children, my favored ones now and forever."

So what do we make of what is in fact a word of judgment and warning? What if we used today's lesson from James as a signal, much like a blinking yellow light on a car's dashboard.? Perhaps God is installing an early warning system to caution us, calling us to a higher way of relating with each other. If that is so, then today is the day of great blessing and hope. With one voice, we can confess what the Gospel teaches: all of us are beloved and favorite children of God.

Look around God's gathered people and see with me with young and old. Notice how unique and beautifully different we are. Savor the variety of God's family and remember with me that everyone gathered here, and indeed the entire human family, matters to the One in whose image we are made, and by whose grace and love we are made God's people now and forever.

Remember, a parish community begins to grow when we allow collaborating in both of our parishes as a united family, different but united in One Faith, One Baptism, and One Lord .

I, as your pastor, invite all of the members of both St. Mary of the Angels, and Saints Peter and Paul parishes to find common ways to collaborate more closely in matters of evangelizing and sharing our faith with one another. My theme for both of our parish communities this year is "UNITED WE STAND, DIVIDED WE FALL."
