May these promises allow us to face the future with hope.

Masses for the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated at St. Mary of the Angels at 6:00pm on Friday, Dec. 7<sup>th</sup>, And here at Ss. Peter & Paul on Saturday Dec. 8<sup>th</sup> at 8:30am.

The 4pm Mass on Saturday, as well as the Masses on Sunday, will be celebrated for the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Week of Advent.

Let us gather at either parish church to celebrate this doctrine of our faith.
